Due to the economic downturn caused by our current pandemic, we are expecting a significant decline in state revenue for Oregon public schools in the 2020-21 school year. As a cost-saving measure to help offset some of the projected revenue shortfall in the 2020-21 school year, Lane ESD is implementing furlough days this spring. Therefore, there will be no teacher-led instruction on the following dates:

- Friday, May 22
- Friday, May 29
- Friday, June 5
- Thursday, June 11

While teachers will not be providing teacher-led instruction on Friday, they will be providing independent work for students to complete on these dates.

We realize that this has already been an extremely disruptive spring and we apologize for any further disruptions this may cause to your students and your schedule. We also regret this late notice; the Lane ESD Board made this decision at a special meeting last night. A priority we have is to make this impact as little as it can be on the families, while attempting to maintain the current level of instruction during distance learning.

Along with Lane ESD, at least ten Lane County School Districts are cutting school days this spring, shortening the 2019-20 school year.

Our goal is always to provide the highest quality of program possible. Our staff is dedicated to continue to provide that to our students through distance learning on the other originally scheduled days. Our teachers will be reaching out to you and your students to help make the adjustments needed to accomplish this goal

We look forward to the time when we will be able to see all our students in person. Until then, please take care and stay safe.
